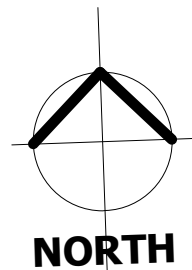


- 1. Animal grazing paddocks
Lucerne, clover, rye grass, kangaroo grass
- 2. Crop & green manure paddocks
Potatoes, chicory, lupins, rye corn, yellow mustard oats, barley
For animal feed & grain, for green manure to be dug back into soil
These paddocks will feed a couple of pigs, and mainly poultry
- 3. For protection
These are watercourses/gullies & proposed to be protected and revegetated
- 4. For protection and/or native revegetation
These are existing stands of native trees and forest to remain and used as sources of biodiversity
- 5. Shelter belt & tree crops
Tagasaste, Silver/black wattle, saltbush. These tree crops will provide fodder, shelter and habitat for both farm stock and native animals
- 6. Annual crops, gardens, orchards
Cabbage for winter production
Garlic for summer production
- 7. Water supply
